### ABOUT ANZEMET

Anzemet Injection is a clear, colorless, nonpyrogenic, sterile solution for intravenous administration. Each milliliter of Anzemet Injection contains 20 mg of dolasetron mesylate and 38.2 mg mannitol with an acetate buffer in water for injection. The pH of the resulting solution is 3.2 to 3.8.

#### ANZEMET INJECTION IS INDICATED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- The prevention of nausea and vomiting associated with initial and repeat courses of emetogenic cancer chemotherapy, including high dose cisplatin
- The prevention of postoperative nausea and vomiting
- The treatment of postoperative nausea and/or vomiting

### ABOUT TAXOTERE

Taxotere (docetaxel) is an antineoplastic agent belonging to the taxoid family. It is prepared by semisynthesis beginning with a precursor extracted from the renewable needle biomass of yew plants.

#### TAXOTERE IS INDICATED FOR:

- The treatment of patients with locally advanced or metastatic breast cancer after failure of prior chemotherapy
- The treatment of patients with locally advanced or metastatic non-small cell lung cancer after failure of prior platinum-based chemotherapy
